Medical professionals are needed to provide support and hands-on training in MTI clinics in remote areas of Southwest and West Nile, Uganda. As a member of a 2-4-person team, you would work alongside national, clinical staff to improve health services and capacity for refugee and local populations, impacting over 1 million beneficiaries. The current project focuses on development and capacity building of national providers through mentorship, collaborative case studies, and CME (continued medical education) trainings. Possible topics for teaching and training focus on areas of medicine such as cardiac health, respiratory health, high-risk and abnormal pregnancies, diseases of the liver, and wound care. ***International experience is required and experience working in Africa is strongly preferred.***

MTI Nepal will be working in collaboration with other local implementers to increase community resilience to the impacts of acute injury and illness from disasters and medical emergencies by the provision of integrated Emergency Medical Services (EMS) in Dhading District. The goal will be to build capacity of national healthcare providers to deliver quality Emergency Medical Care. **Requirements include the following: providing and teaching EMS topics related to remote and improvised care, previous international experience and experience teaching in rural settings.**

The entire application process must be completed before a disaster occurs to qualify for deployment. This includes all application materials, a background check, and an interview with an MTI coordinator as well as humanitarian response training. If you desire to serve on a future humanitarian response team, please begin the application process early. Using our pre-vetted roster helps us to be one of the first on the scene providing immediate care.

Notes on International Volunteer Opportunities

- **Projected costs** typically include airfare, food, lodging, ground transportation, and medical evacuation insurance unless otherwise noted. Many costs are tax deductible if you are a US resident, but we recommend talking to a tax consultant to determine specifics.
- **Fundraising** is available through a webpage MTI sets up for the team. All donations to the team are tax-deductible if you're a resident of the US.
- **Faith requirements** are noted where appropriate. Medical Teams International does not have faith requirements for volunteers, but some of our in country partners request that we send Christian volunteers, which is noted where applicable.
